Vasyl Zatsikha, violin Andriy Dragan, piano



Vasyl Zatsikha is a prize-winning violinist, celebrated for his achievements in several prestigious competitions. He won 1st Prize in the Rahn Music Prize, 2nd Prize in the Schoenfeld International String Competition, 2nd Prize in the Premio Rodolfo Lipizer 2017, and the Grand Prix at the Pila Festival. He was also a semifinalist in the Queen Elisabeth Violin Competition. Zatsikha has performed with distinguished ensembles, including the Lucerne Symphony Orchestra, Harbin Symphony Orchestra, and Orchestre Royal de Chambre de Wallonie. Since 2021, he serves as the principal second violinist of the Orchestra della Svizzera Italiana.



Andriy Dragan

Swiss-Ukrainian pianist Andriy Dragan has earned numerous accolades, including the Credit Suisse Jeunes Solistes award in 2009 and the 1st Prize along with the Prix Collard from the Kiefer-Hablitzel Foundation in 2013. Dragan has graced stages at major festivals such as the Lucerne Festival, Verbier Festival, Gstaad Menuhin Festival, Zaubersee Festival in Lucerne, Zermatt Music Festival, Bergen Festival, and Rheingau Musik Festival. His international engagements include Schloss Elmau, La Roque d'Anthéron, Festival d'Auvers-sur-Oise, as well as the Kontraste and Virtuosen Festivals in Lviv. He has performed with prominent orchestras, including the Munich Radio Orchestra, Lucerne Symphony Orchestra, Basel Symphony Orchestra, Musikkollegium Winterthur, and the Zermatt Festival Orchestra, collaborating with the Scharoun Ensemble of the Berlin Philharmonic, MDR Symphony Orchestra at the Gewandhaus in Leipzig, and the INSO Lviv Orchestra.
